# AYURVEDIC LINE OF TREATMENT ON VATAJA SHIRAHSHOOL – A SINGLE CASE STUDY

#### **ABSTRACT**

Vatika shirahshool is most common among all shiroroga which is mentioned by the acharyas but till date no satisfactory treatment is available for Vatika shirahshoola. All medical systems are presently treating this condition symptomatically but permanent solution is not found. Numbers of researches have been carried out in this direction; till search for complete remission is awaited. Therefore, search for a safer management from other systems of medicine is of greater interest. This forces the need to have a drug which and cure the disease without any adverse effects. As per Acharya Susruta in Vatika Shirahshool all the treatment should be done like Vatavyadhi Chikitsa. In present case study reveals a role of Bruhan Nasya ,which give beneficial effect in the management of Vataja Shirahshool.

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#### INTRODUCTION

In Ayurveda, Shiras is considered as the Uttamanga, as it is the seat of prana and indriyas.<sup>i</sup> Among the urdhwa jatrugathavikaras, shiroroga is having an important place. Acharya Charaka explains that the term Shiroroga represents Shirashoola.<sup>ii</sup> Ayurvedic classics has given detailed explanation and classification of Shirashoola. Even though all the Shirorogas are tridoshaja, it has been classified based up on the predominant dosha.<sup>iii</sup> Among them vataja shirashoola is most frequently seen because of the vata prakopaka nidanas like of ruksha ahar seven, adhikpurovata sevan, yatayat gaman, shita ambu sevan etc are more prevalent in the current era due to life style modification. In Ayurveda, Shirahshoola is the main symptom as well as synonyms of various shiro-roga. It is separate disease entity which has symptoms and pathology as per the Doshika involvement. Acharya Sushruta describes 11 types of Shirahshoola which are according to the involvement of Kapha, Pitta, Vata and Rakta individually as well as combined <sup>iv</sup>Shiro Roga which occurs due to the vataprakopaka nidanas with intense pain in the head, neck and the regions surrounding it is termed as vataja shira shoola.

#### **CASEREPORT**

A 28-year-old Hindu ,female, , non-diabetic, normotensive Patient came to the opd of Government Akhandanand *Ayurved* Mahavidyalaya,Ahmedabad on 22 october, 2021 having the chief complaints of

- \* Nistudhyate bhrusham shankho (Pricking pain in temporal region since 6 to 7 years)
- ❖ *Vama Karna Shoola* (Pain in left ear since 15 days)
- ❖ Nasa Strava (Watery Nasal Discharge since 15 days

#### **CASEFINDINGS**

The patient was asymptomatic before 7 years after that time of period patient sudden started continuous headache, She was having severe pain in B/L on temporal region which was unbearable and patient have to take pain killers. she got relief after taking pain

killers and also feels good while massaging on head. Occasionally she develops GI track symptoms such as nausea and vomiting while headache attack along with left ear pain and nasal secretions occurs sometimes. Patient come here to our hospital with hope of permanent solutions.

#### **PAST HISTORY:**

Patient had frequently taken allopathy medicine.

**FAMILY HISTORY:** There was no any disease related family history found in this case.

#### PERSONAL HISTORY

- Malapravritti- vibandha 2 time /day unsatisfactory defecation
- Mutrapravritti- 6-8 time/24 hrs

#### DASHA VIDHA PARIKSHA

Prakriti of the patient was vata Pradhana kapha, Vatapradhana tridosha vikruti was observed during the analysis. Satwa, Sara, Samhanana, Ahara Shakti, Vyayama Shakti, Satmya and Pramana of the patient were Madhyam.

#### **DISEASE SPECIFIC EXAMINATIONS**

**Nose -** Anterior Rhinoscopy

- Septum- slightly deviated to left
- Mucosa- pinkish
- ❖ Turbinate- right inferior turbinate hypertrophy

#### **Throat**

- Posterior.Pharyngeal Wall. Normal
- Palatine tonsils Normal

Ear – Otoscopic examination

- ❖ External Audiotory Canal −B/L clear
- **❖** Tympanic Membrane − Intact

#### **Paranasal sinus examination:**

- On Examination tenderness present on Frontal and Ethmoid sinus
- There was no tenderness present on Sphenoid and maxillary sinus

**Investigations:** Routine haematological and urine investigations were normal.

#### TREATMENT PROTOCOL

- > first seven days in aamaavstha treatment protocol
  - 1. Hingvastaka churna 3gm with Go-ghrita- 2time with first bolus of food
  - 2. Pathyadi Kwath 10 gm + Eranda Sneha ( 1 tsf) 2 time before meal with guda

#### After niramaystha treatment protocol

- > Shiraha shuladi vajra rasa 2 tab 2 time after meal
- ➤ Bala taila bruhana nasya (8-8 drop in both nostrils) for 7 days

#### **DISCUSSION**

➤ Patient has history of ruksha ahar sevan, adhikpurovata sevan, yatayat gaman, shita ambu sevan. And mansik santap. Due to this all causative factors jatharagni becomes manda vayu becomes pratiloma after that vitiated dosha accumulated at shira Pradesh and then shiroroga manifested. Shirahshoola is one among the shiroroga. Which is mainly caused by vatadosha .Afetr Diagnosed aamavstha of patient Hingvastaka churna vas given for Deepan (appetizer) and Pachan (digestion) which help digest the food

and having vata Anulomana effect, so it is effective in the management of vatika shirahsoola.

- ➤ Pathyadi decoction is mentioned in Sharandhar Samhita <sup>vi</sup>, specially in the management ofshiroroga. This decoction has ingredients having ushna virya ( hot potency ) and Vata Shamaka (vata subsiding) property which can be beneficial in vatika Shirahshool as this disease has dominancy of vitiation of Vataja dosha.
- In niram avastha bala taila brimhana nasya was given because Bala tail is useful in the management of all type of vata vyadhi explained in the classies.
- ➤ Bala taila having vatahara, shoolahara properties and also it provide bhrimhana may be very useful in the treatment of Shirahshoola. Nasya is the best treatment modality that can be adopted in the management of vatika shirahshoola.
- The nasya Karma is effective in the treatment of all urdhwajatrugata Vikara .Bruhana type of nasya will helps in eradicating vatika disorders.Acharya vagabhatta has given some more details about the mode of action .it is explained that Nasa being door way to shirah, vii the drug administrated through nostrils reaches shringataka, a sirahmarma by nasa strota Nd spread in the Murdha (Brain), taking routes of netra (eyes), shrotra (ears), kantha (throat), sira mukha and scratches the morbid dosha in urdhwajatru and extract from uttamanga.
- Shirahshooladi vjraarasa is mentioned in shiroroga by bhaisajaya ratnavali. Which is indicated in ekdoshaja, dwidosha, tridoshaja and all type of Shiroroga.

#### **CONCLUSION**

As per above mention case discussion, it can be concluded that Bruhan Nasya is effective therapy in Vataja Shirahshool. This therapy should be used in large sample as a clinical trail.

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
